Beginning Copper Plate Intaglio (Etching)

The session covers plate preparation, multiple forms of mark making onto a copper plate, and creating etched lines on a copper plate with ferric chloride solution, a non-toxic process. Participants will also learn basic plate printing processes such as applying ink to the plate, wiping the plate and operating the intaglio printing press.

The first evening session is a demo of the process; at the second session you will create the plate and print your image multiple times.
