## **Introduction to Relief Printing**

Saturday, January 14, 2023 from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM This class is for anyone interested in learning one of the oldest forms of print-making! Beginning with an explanation and demo of the process and materials, participants will design and carve a relief plate, apply ink to it, and then hand print the plate using a baren. We will be using easy to carve plates made from recycled materials, and a variety of eco-friendly and recycled papers. All supplies and tools will be provided. This class is open to all. *No experience is necessary*.

## Introduction to Collagraph

Saturday, January 28, 2023 from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM

Collagraph is an open-ended printmaking technique limited only by imagination. A collagraph plate can be ANYTHING glued to a surface, rolled with ink and printed. We will be using limited materials in order to have time to get to know their characteristics and also experience some different ways of plate-making and inking. No experience is necessary.

## Valentines! Letterpress Card Happy Hour

Friday evening, February 3, 2023 from 6:30 PM – 9:00 PM

Enjoy a creative adventure in printmaking using the relief method and our wonderful vintage Vandercook letterpress. Using our collection of Valentine theme linoleum relief blocks, learn to operate the press and produce a lovely set of greeting cards (envelopes included). No experience is necessary.

## Intro to Silkscreen: Photo Emulsion Baby Oil Xerox

Saturday, February 11, 2023 from 12:00 to 4:00 PM

Love photo emulsion but can't find transparency printers? Hate using so much plastic? Or just want to learn how to Screen Print your digital images? Learn how to do just that with the Baby Oil Xerox Method! Participants will learn how to prepare pre-drawn digital images for printing, as well as the basics of silkscreen printmaking. Image should not exceed 8.5 x 11. No experience is necessary.

## **Pulp** Painting

Saturday, March 11, 2023 from 3:30 PM to 6:30 PM

Learn how to create paper and a finished art piece in one workshop! Participants will use a variety of techniques to layer pigmented pulp onto a freshly pulled sheet of wet paper creating a beautifully colorful image. You will take home 5 to 10 finished pulp paintings.

## Advanced Exploration with Collagraphs & Drypoint

Saturday, March 25, 2023 from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM

Experience required - Participants must have attended a previous collagraph workshop or be experienced in collagraph printing. Using a variety of self-adhesive tapes, sandpaper and incised lines, participants will create a small 3 color collagraph on three plexiglass plates. Participants will need to be prepared with a design that is separated for three colors. These prints will combine collagraph concepts with drypoint. Participants will also learn how to register three colors and print a small edition of 4 prints.

## Printing with Lego<sup>®</sup>

#### Saturday, May 6, 2023 from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM

Combine traditional printmaking with the contemporary materials of Lego®. Create prints from flat tiles/DOTS® by hand printing with a baren and using the letterpress. Each participant will have their own plate as well as a community plate on which to design compositions. Discussions will include registration for editioning, composing designs with graph paper vs. computer software, acquiring Lego® for printing, etc. This class is intended for ages 12 and older.

### Solarplate Etching: Level Up with Color

Saturday, July 29, 2023 from 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM

Using your existing Solarplate, learn how to add color to your print using chine collé, pochoir, and monoprint backgrounds. Demonstrations of each technique will be presented. Prerequisite: Participants must bring an existing intaglio solarplate, no larger than 9"x12", created in a previous Solarplate etching workshop.

## Multi-Color Linoleum Reduction Printing

Saturday, August 26, 2023 from 10:00 AM - 2:00 PM

Prerequisite: Participants must already be familiar with relief printing and using linoleum carving tools. Participants are encouraged to bring their own carving tools. Using water-soluble inks, participants will create a multi-color relief print using ONLY ONE linoleum plate by employing the reduction printing method! An explanation of the process will be followed by the initial carving of the linoleum block and printing of the first impression. Participants will continue cutting away areas of the linoleum plate between each color pass and print the remainder of the impressions.

## Sintra<sup>®</sup> Plate Intaglio & Relief

Sunday, September 10, 2023 from 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM

Inexpensive, versatile and straightforward to manipulate, Sintra® is a PVC-based material we will be using to create a matrix (printing surface) for this workshop. You will be drawing lines into the surface with a ballpoint pen to create an image for your matrix. The matrix will be printed with two distinctly different techniques. First, the matrix will be printed as a relief print with ink rolled onto the surface with a brayer and a smooth sheet of paper. Second, it will be printed as an intaglio print with ink pushed into the lines and a dampened soft paper. Drawing on the Sintra®, as well as the two different printing methods will be demonstrated.

## .918 Type High Haikus

#### September 16 & 19, 2023: Two Session Workshop

Session One: Saturday, September 16 from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM and Session Two: Tuesday evening, September 19 from 5:00 to 8:00 PM Celebrate Type High Day at Phoenix Rising! Type high refers to the measurement of 0.918, the height of type or plates that can be be printed on the letterpress. Learn the fundamentals of letterpress while printing your own haiku and small illustration for a class chapbook. Session Two involves composing and sewing the chapbook and is a drop-in session.

## 3-Color Monotypes: The Wonders of Transparent Color

Saturday, October 7, 2023 from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Explore the basics of color theory using transparent ink. Starting with a simple image that has been separated into areas for each color, we will use Process Red, Blue and Yellow ink to create a full-color image. As the colors overlap, creating all the colors of the rainbow, participants will see their image come to life! Some experience needed. Basic knowledge of Color Theory is helpful!

## Aquatint: Gova with a Twist!

#### Saturday, October 14, 2023 from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM

Like etching, Aquatint is an intaglio printmaking technique, but is used to create tonal effects rather than lines. This workshop is an environmentally friendly twist on this 18th century technique. For this workshop we will be using products that you can find around your house, such as powdered sugar instead of rosin, and vinegar and salt as etching solution to create your image. You will learn how to create perfectly etched metal plates in a nontoxic way!
